

#### NICOLA CERRONE

Outsides, baby sea urchins represented by seed pearls, adorned with sapphire halos as the ocean.

#### AURORA AUSTRALIS

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Ribbons of contrasting matte gold and polished platinum twist around the neck, meeting at an Australian parti sapphire. Separating the delicate framework are step-cut diamonds and a Parti sapphire. Stones held in two-tone bezel, connecting the opposite metal.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"Australians have been turning their attention toward our incredible native land, sea and skyscapes. Inspired by the Southern Lights phenomenon visible from TAS, VIC and SA, *Aurora* is a celebration and a showcase of the incredible beauty Australia has to offer."

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct yellow gold, platinum, 4.16ct Bi-colour custom cut Australian sapphire, 1.35ct custom cut Parti sapphire, diamonds



#### **Emily Snadden**

#### THE TURNING OF THE FAGUS

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Hand manufactured in four tone gold, the branch style neckpiece curls around the wearer mimicking the autumnal turning of foliage through the use of graduated gold leaves. Central is a freeform sapphire to mimic the outline of Crater Lake. Scattered are diamond puddles referencing highland snow fall.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"Inspired by Tasmania's iconic Crater Lake at Cradle Mountain and the annual turning of the endemic Nothofagus Gunnii. During April and May the leaves begin to turn, displaying a spectacular show of autumn colour, often combined with dustings of snow."

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct yellow, white, rose and green gold, diamonds, custom cut natural Australian Parti sapphire



#### Hand made from granules of metal, melted and formed. Each component soldered, textured. Finished to soft white appearance. Rose quartz pink wattle busts, held by rose gold. An ant holding a pink diamond.

Each diamond subtle, like dew on a leaf. When worn, the kinetic movement is like branches swaying.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"The hairpin itself, is inspired by the critically endangered, Acacia Purpureopetala, known as Cupid's wattle. The only pink flowering wattle in Australia. Dwelling high in the branches of the wattle, alongside the birds and bees, feasting on fragrant pink blossom is an unexpected resident - the ant."

Sterling silver, 9ct and 18ct rose gold, natural rose quartz, pink Australian diamond, white diamonds

Nimue is a reflection of the tranquillity to be found along the fringes of society. The piece depicts a matte lakeside scattered with fallen leaves, which gives way in a glittering transition to Nimue herself.

#### **MOTIVATION**

I've known for a while that this tourmaline was going to be the stone I used for a competition piece. I also really enjoy wax carving faces and using movement in jewellery so Nimue sort of fell into place from there."

22ct, 18ct yellow gold, 18ct white and rose gold, tourmaline and diamond

#### QUEEN IN THE GARDEN OF EDEN

#### DESCRIPTION

Handmade yellow gold ring with a multi coloured extravaganza of jewels from the gem kingdom sourced from various global regions. The rubellite is the hero, surrounded by a halo of Australian vivid yellow diamonds. A secret pink diamond sourced from the Argyle mine is set on the rings interior.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"To create a ring representing love, romance, life and paradise. The woman, I designed for; is an art collector, an international person who loves colour. The lady was my muse, and she loves life and lives a life full of colour. A testament for the colours of mother nature; the precious gift to humanity."

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct yellow gold, rubellite, white, vivid yellow and pink Argyle diamonds, pink sapphires, emeralds, tanzanite





THE SPANISH DANCER

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This hand carved pendant has been made in yellow gold with diamonds and one South Sea pearl.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"The 'Spanish Dancer' is a part of the Nudibranch (Nudibranchia) family found in the Western Australian Coral Coast. The beguiling and hypnotic movement of this sea slug has inspired the curved edges of the pendant along with the polished and textured finish in the gold. Motivated by a recent holiday in Coral Bay, WA, I have created this pendant with a South Sea pearl for colour contrast and diamonds to reflect the light with movement."

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct yellow gold, 10-11mm South Sea pearl, diamonds



FISSURE

#### **DESCRIPTION**

A statement ring featuring South Sea baroque pearl, diamonds in a hand-sculpted gold setting.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"Fissure is inspired by the crevices in melting ice caps and dried earth. Each piece in the collection is hand-carved into a three-dimensional lattice with lines mimicking those found in nature. A thoughtful design logic hides between the organic lines, contributing to balanced compositions of seemingly random components."

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct yellow gold, white diamonds, South Sea baroque pearl

#### **DESCRIPTION**



Each claw set in rose gold, and descending in weight in this full-set style; Riri pushing boundaries and setting trends. Diamonds seen from the front and profile of this piece, in a bead setting.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"This show stopping piece was sketched after a popularity poll, where our social media followers chose the celebrity they most resonated with, so our lead designer could create a completely custom engagement ring inspired by the chosen star. The majority voted for style icon and musician, Rihanna.

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct white and rose gold, slightly graduating pink morganites, 1 point colourless white diamonds

#### **MOTIVATION**

"My motivation is to enhance ones beauty."

#### **MATERIALS**

18ct white gold, black rhodium, 224 brown diamonds, 14 fancy gold colour diamonds, 18 sapphires



Sterling silver ring and two 6mm topaz (one rub set and one grain set upside down) and diamonds grain set. Representing fusion of an underwater volcanic landscape and ice.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"To take two opposites of the world which I call home. The icy lakes of Germany in winter time to the deep ocean and volcanic landscape of Taranaki, New Zealand, I wanted to merge the two to create one piece of unique jewellery."

#### **MATERIALS**

SHIRE GLADE

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Showcasing a playful piece of Coober Pedy white opal, the hand-carved baby rabbit, with Australian blue sapphire eyes, is the centrepiece of this double frame tri-tone ring. Nestled on top of individually sculpted, rose gold satin-finished autumn leaves, hides between tourmaline flowers, mirrored with diamonds, trailing down the sides. Each flower holds a white and yellow gold centre stem. Held together with white gold bars, the frame wraps around and highlights the inside edges. Curving its way to the final detail in rose gold, the last leaf hugs a concave base shaped to display the ring as a mini sculpture.

#### **MOTIVATION**

"A Glade is an open clearing in a wood or a forest. This piece is called Shire Glade after the meaning of my sisters' name. 


